Who comes up with the names of countries? The name for the country was coined in 1933 by the Pakistani independence activist from India, Rahmat Ali. He derived it from the names of five regions of India that later became Pakistan: Punjab, Afghanistan, Kashmir, Sindh, and Balochistan. The first letters of the first four regions were taken, and from the last one, the suffix «stan» was added. Later, for easier pronunciation, the letter «I» was added, resulting in «Pakistan,» which translates to...
