Введение

Данное издание представляет собой учебное пособие, направленное на развитие навыков устной и письменной речи на английском языке у подростков. В книге собраны тематические материалы, отражающие актуальные сферы интересов учащихся данного возрастного периода, включая вопросы образования, межличностного общения, цифровой среды, досуга и профессионального самоопределения.
