Can a country grant citizenship for money? The name Egypt comes from ancient Greek Αἴγυπτος, later from ancient

Egyptian Hikuptah (the name of the ancient capital of Egypt, Greek Μέμφις, Memphis), from Het-Ka-Ptah “the house of Ka Ptah.” The Greeks used this word to refer to all of Egypt. From here, the term passed through Latin Aegyptus into other European languages. The Egyptians themselves called their country kmt (Kemet) or Ta-kemet, which translates to “black land, black soil” due to the fertile black soil in the Nile Valley. In Russian, it comes from Old Russian, Old Slavic Егѹпѣтъ, from Greek. Citizenship of Egypt cannot be obtained...
